# **RECOMMENDED USES**

- Bonding of linoleum & PVC foam backing
- Bonding of floor cork with PVC at the top & bottom of the needle felt
- Bonding flexible vinyl sheets & tiles flooring
- · Bonding vinyl sheet on gypsum boards
- Bonding all types of vinyl wallpaper

### **STORAGE**

- Should be stored tightly closed and away from direct sunlight in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area between 5°C to 39°C
- Protect from freezing
- Close the container tightly when not in use

# **SURFACE PREPARATION**

All surfaces must be clean, dry and free from dust, dirt, paint, loose materials, oil, grease, sealers, curing compounds, waxes and all other contaminations.

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### **APPLICATION METHOD**

- Make sure that the surfaces are dry, leveled in position and ready for application.
- Spread the adhesive with a notched trowel to a surface area of 2 m<sup>2</sup>, which can be tiled in the adhesive's open time
- Fix the tiles within 20 30 minutes after application of adhesive while it is still wet then press the tiles firmly ensuring that the adhesive covers the back portion of the tiles completely.
- The plastic cross fixtures should be placed at the corners of each tiles, which leads to the formation of clearance in between tiles to be filled with the grout.
- Fill the joints with grout at least 24 hours later. Corner joints & top edge should be filled with the suitable joint filler to stop the penetration of water.
- After 24 hours the plastic cross fixtures should be removed & the grout can be applied
- Wallpaper or vinyl carpet application, first the plasterboard or the surface must be completely covered with adhesive.
- For outside application don't start work if rain is forecasted for the following 24 hrs

# **CLEANING & DISPOSAL**

- Wet material is cleaned immediately with Water
- The Tools & the excess material should be cleaned immediately with water before it gets dry
- Dry product may stains can be removed mechanically
- Dispose the waste according to the local regulations

# SHELF LIFE

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18 months shelf life when stored in it's original unopened container between 5°C to 39°C.

# **HEALTH & SAFETY**

The product is generally safe, non-toxic and non-flammable in wet condition.

The product should not be swallowed or allowed to come into contact with skin and eyes. Use of suitable protective gloves and goggles is advisable.
